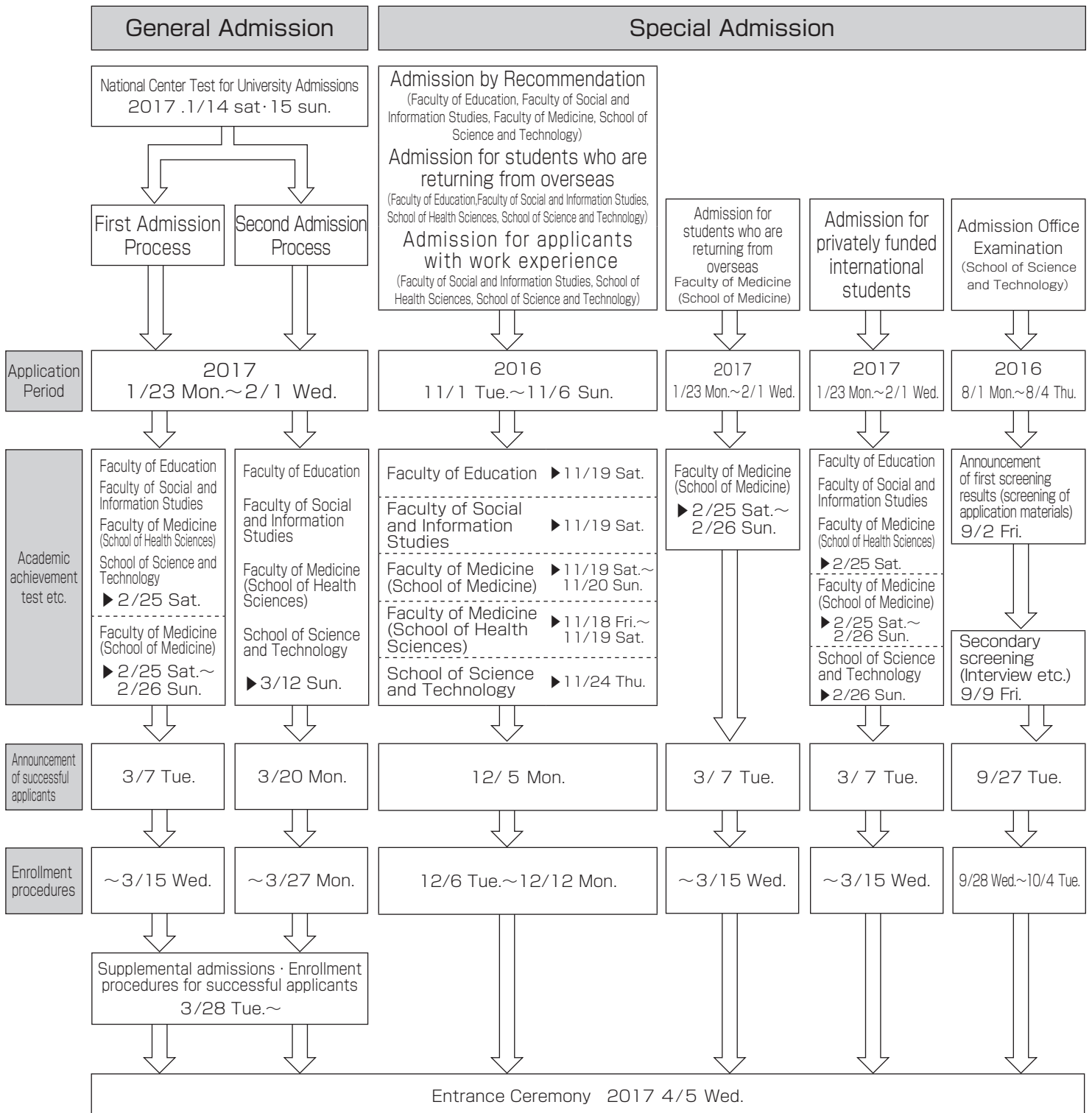


## Overview of 2017 Admission Process for Privately-Funded International Students

International students are exempted from the National Center Test for University Admissions. The result of the Examination for Japanese University Admission for International Students (EJU) administered by Japan Student Services Organization (for those who are applying for the School of Science and Technology, a score on one of the following tests taken in or after January 2015 is also required: TOEFL-PBT, TOEFL-iBT, TOEFL-ITP (administered by Gunma University), TOEIC public test, TOEIC-IP (administered by Gunma University) or IELTS) as well as an academic achievement test individually administered by each department and academic transcripts are comprehensively evaluated.

**Note : Education is offered in the same manner to international students and students enrolled through special or general admission process**

Remarks

1. Graduates from the Faculty of Education will be awarded a teachers license. Eligibility to apply for teaching positions varies depending on prefectural and city governments. Please contact the board of education for each prefectural or city government.
2. Graduates from the School of Medicine will be eligible to sit for the national examination for medical practitioners
3. Graduates from the School of Health Sciences will be eligible to sit for national examinations related to their majored subjects
4. For those who applying for the School of Science and Technology, the score for TOEFL-PBT, TOEFL-iBT, TOEFL-ITP, TOEIC public test, TOEIC-IP or IELTS is verified as follows:

Test score subject to verification	Verification method
Score for TOEFL-PBT or TOEFL-iBT (administered in or after January 2015)	Please submit the original and a copy (on A-4 paper) of Examinee Score Report addressed to the applicant. The original will be returned to the applicant together with examination admission ticket.
Score for TOEFL-ITP (administered by Gunma University in or after January 2015)	Please submit the original and a copy (on A-4 paper) of the score card for TOEFL-ITP administered by Gunma University. The original will be returned to the applicant together with examination admission ticket.
Score for TOEFL public test (administered in or after January 2015)	Please submit the original and a copy (on A-4 paper) of Official Score Certificate. The original will be returned to the applicant together with examination admission ticket.
Score for TOEIC-IP (administered by Gunma University in or after January 2015)	Please submit the original and a copy (on A-4 paper) of the Score Report for TOEFL-ITP administered by Gunma University. The original will be returned to the applicant together with examination admission ticket.
Score for IELTS (administered in or after January 2015)	Please submit the original and a copy (on A-4 paper) of Test Report Form addressed to the applicant. The original will be returned to the applicant together with examination admission ticket.

## How to make a Payment of Examination Fee at Convenience Store or by Credit Card

You can pay the examination fee at a nearby Convenience Store(Lawson, Ministop, FamilyMart, Seven-Eleven, Circle K or Sunkus) by cash, or by a credit card.

### 1 Online Application

※You can not correct or cancel anything once your credit card payment has been made. Please check all your information carefully before you confirm the application.

※If you input the wrong information while trying to obtain your application number, please start again from the beginning and make your payment. If you fail to pay the fee by the due date which you will be noticed after completing the online application, all the information you had input will be canceled automatically.

### 2 Convenience Store Payment

The application fee cannot be paid through an ATM. Be sure to make your payment at the counter.

A multifunction copier can not be used to make payment.

- Make the payment at the register.

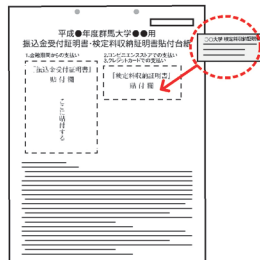
#### Paying at Convenience Store

※When attaching the certificate of payment, be sure to use glue which is suitable for use with thermal paper and pressure-sensitive paper. Please check the glue label.



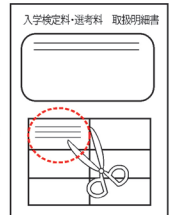
※In the case that you have made your payment using a credit card or at a Convenience Store, you don't need to enclose a bank receipt of any kind.

#### Paying by Credit Card

After making your payment, please make sure you have access to a printer with paper(A4). Access "申込内容照会"(Inquiry) at e-shiharai.net.

Please 「1. Check your card.」 「2. Input Receipt Number.」 「3. Input your Birth Date.(YYYY/MM/DD)」, and click "照会する". Then all of your application information is displayed. Click Blue-button "証明書を発行する". Attach the cutting portion of "取納証明書"(The Certificate of Payment) in the designated location.

Enclose in an envelope with all other necessary application documents.



- Please confirm the information on the documents and complete your payment within the application period.
  - If you are paying at a convenience store, please be sure to complete your web application at least 30min before the end of the payment period time.
- In addition, the steps for using information terminals at various convenience stores and payment deadlines for credit card payments are all mentioned in your application guidelines.

- You can print a receipt from the "Application Results" page on the E-shiharai site after making credit card payments only.
- Please contact your credit card company directly if your card is not accepted.
