
Overview of 2021 Admission Process for Privately-Funded International Students

International students are exempted from the National Center Test for University Admissions. The result of the Examination for Japanese University Admission for International Students (EJU) administered by Japan Student Services Organization as well as an academic achievement test individually administered by each department and academic transcripts are comprehensively evaluated.

Note: Education is offered in the same manner to international students and students enrolled through special or general admission process

Applicant who has taken the high school equivalence test individually administered by our university, and is determined to possess academic background equivalent or superior to high school graduate (Note 2). Applicant who has taken the 2020 Examination for Japanese University Admission for International Students administered by Japan Student Services Organization (either 1st session or 2nd session) as follows (Note 3).
