
Overview of 2023 Admission Process for Privately-Funded International Students

International students are exempted from the Common Test for University Admissions. The result of the Examination for Japanese University Admission for International Students (EJU) administered by Japan Student Services Organization (for those who are applying for the School of Science and Technology, a score on one of the following tests taken in or after January 2021 is also required: TOEFL-iBT, TOEFL-ITP (administered by Gunma University), TOEIC Listening&Reading Test, TOEIC-IP (administered by Gunma University) or IELTS) as well as an academic achievement test individually administered by each department and academic transcripts are comprehensively evaluated.

Note : Education is offered in the same manner to international students and students enrolled through special or general admission process

Score for IELTS (administered in or after January 2021)	Please submit a copy (on A-4 paper) of Test Report Form addressed to the applicant.
