

Overview of 2026 Admission Process for Privately-Funded International Students

International students are exempted from the Common Test for University Admissions. The result of the Examination for Japanese University Admission for International Students (EJU) administered by Japan Student Services Organization (for those who are applying for the School of Science and Technology, a score on one of the following tests taken in or after January 2024 is also required: TOEFL-iBT, TOEFL-ITP (administered by Gunma University), TOEIC Listening&Reading Test, TOEIC-IP (administered by Gunma University) or IELTS) as well as an academic achievement test individually administered by each department and academic transcripts are comprehensively evaluated.

The mode and quality of education are identical for international students and for students admitted through either the special or general admission process.

Qualifications	Applicants who meet the following criteria may apply 1. Applicant who is not a Japanese citizen, and holds or is expected to have resident status that does not forbid them from entering universities under the provisions of the Immigration Control and Refugee Recognition Act, except for those who are allowed permanent residency in Japan (Note 1). 2. Applicant who meets one of the following (1) Applicant who has completed or plans to complete all the requirements of a 12 school year education system in foreign country by March 31, 2026 or has equivalent requirements as certified by Ministry of Education, Culture, Sports, Science and Technology (2) Applicant who has obtained one of the following qualifications : International Baccalaureate (awarded by the International Baccalaureate Organization), Abitur (designated by the Federal Republic of Germany) including reife, Baccalaureate (designated by the French Republic), General Certificate of Education Advanced Level or International General Certificate of Education Advanced Level (awarded by the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland)[passed at least one subject (grade E or higher)] , or European Baccalaureate (awarded by the European Union member states). (4) Applicant who has taken the high school equivalence test individually administered by our university, and is determined to possess an academic background equivalent or superior to high school graduate, and who will be 18 years of age by March 31,2026 (Note 2). 3. Applicant who has taken the 2025 Examination for Japanese University Admission for International Students administered by Japan Student Services Organization (either 1st session or 2nd session) as follows (Note 3). Remarks

1. Graduates from the Cooperative Faculty of Education will be awarded a teachers license. Eligibility to apply for teaching positions varies depending on prefectural and city governments. Please contact the board of education for each prefectural or city government.
2. Graduates from the School of Medicine will be eligible to sit for the national examination for medical practitioners
3. Graduates from the School of Health Sciences will be eligible to sit for national examinations related to their majored subjects
4. For those who are applying for the School of Science and Technology, the score for TOEFL-iBT, TOEFL-ITP, TOEIC Listening & Reading Test, TOEIC-IP or IELTS is verified as follows:

Score for TOEIC Listening & Reading Test (administered in or after January 2024)	Please submit a copy (on A-4 paper) of Official Score Certificate.
Score for TOEIC-IP (administered by Gunma University in or after January 2024)	Please submit a copy (on A-4 paper) of the Score Report for TOEFL-ITP administered by Gunma University.
Score for IELTS (administered in or after January 2024)	Please submit a copy (on A-4 paper) of Test Report Form addressed to the applicant.

Those who do not have a Status of Residence are required to obtain a Certificate of Eligibility (CoE). It may take 1-2 months to issue the certificate after application. Please check "在留資格の取得について (About obtaining a Status of Residence)" on the university website (URL/QR code below) in advance, prepare the necessary documents and submit them along with your enrollment procedures. If you are unable to obtain the documents required for a Status of Residence in time, please be sure to complete other enrollment procedures during the period of the enrollment procedure and notify us of the progress of your CoE at that time.
